

GAMBLING AND MATCH-FIXING POLICY KEY MESSAGES FOR ALL PARTICIPANTS

Basketball Australia has zero tolerance for illegal gambling and match-fixing. All Participants and Clubs have a role to play in safeguarding the integrity of basketball.

- **You are not allowed to bet on Basketball matches played in Australia:**
 - Even if it is not your own team or competition.
 - Basketball Australia has agreements with licensed betting operators and runs periodic checks of its membership database to see if Participants have been betting on Australian basketball.
- **Court-siding is not permitted at any basketball matches played in Australia:**
 - All court-siders will be evicted from the premises in accordance with terms of entry.
- **You should always play your best:**
 - Don't fix any aspect of a match or event, even where it might seem like a trivial component.
 - Don't engage in 'tanking' or 'stacking'.
- **Maintain the competitive edge; don't share sensitive information about your team:**
 - This includes, but is not limited to, likely positional line-ups, injury status and selections.
 - Inside Information can be used for gambling and match-fixing purposes.
- **Don't accept any rewards or remuneration outside of your playing and endorsement contracts:**
 - Accepting an unsolicited reward may leave you vulnerable to a match-fixing approach.
- **Report it to the Independent Reporting Hotline:**
 - If you've been approached or seen something suspicious.
 - You are required to report as a condition of your participation in basketball.

- **Basketball Australia will investigate all suspicious conduct:**
 - Basketball Australia monitors betting markets to detect suspicious betting patterns.
 - Basketball Australia may also initiate and outsource investigations.
- **Possible sanctions apply to all Participants, including suspensions and fines.**
