A step-by-step guide to register to The Basketball Network.

Step 1: Choose how many people you are registering



Choose how many adults and children you wish to register to The Basketball Network by selecting the dropdown boxes and choosing the number of people you are about to register. An adult is 18 years or older.

Your email address can be linked to multiple members of your family, you can change the email address for each individual person via member.basketball.net.au

Step 2: Enter Email Address



Enter your email address and click Continue.

You will require an email address to access a self-registration form; this is your unique identifier to ensure the system knows who you are each time you register.

If you are registering for the first time upon entering your email address, a confirmation email will be sent to you. You will need to click on the password creation link within this email to proceed.

If you are a returning participant and the email address you entered isn't recognised, try a different email address. If your email address still isn't recognised, then contact your association administrator to update your personal information.

NB: It is important that you contact your association and don't select the wrong profile as you may be asked to register and pay when your registration fees are not due.





Frequently Asked Questions

Where and how do I access my registration form?

To access your Basketball Registration Form you will need to obtain a Registration Form URL from your association/club.

Associations/clubs often store their Registration Form on their website. If you are unable to find your Registration Form, please contact your association/club directly.

Before I start the self-registration process, what must I have ready?

You will need a copy of your OR the person you are registering's first name, family name, email address and date of birth as well as one of the below:

- Credit Card
- PayPal Account
- PoliPay - Online Banking Username and Password

Do I need an email address to register?

Yes, you or your parent/guardian will require an email address before you can register to The Basketball Network. Yes, there are a number of free email services you can take advantage of, including;

- [Microsoft Outlook](#)
- [Yahoo Mail](#)

What if I can't remember the email address I used to register previously?

If you have registered previously to The Basketball Network, and can't remember the email address you used, we recommend contacting your local basketball state/association/club and ask them to update your profile with an email address of your choice.

If you have previously registered to The Basketball Network, select the 'No, I've registered before' link after entering your email address.

If you enter your email address and it isn't recognised, try an alternate email address; you may have changed your email address since you first registered.

If your email address still isn't recognised, contact your association/club and advise them of your current email address so they can update your email address in the system.

What if I can't remember my password/my password isn't working?

Once you have typed in your email address, click 'Forgot Password'.

A reset password link will be sent to the email address that you provided.

Once you have opened the email, click on the 'Click to reset password' link.

The Member Profile page will open, enter in your new password.

The screen will now state that your password has been successfully changed. Press the Click here to continue button to continue your self-registration.

You must check your email and activate your account by setting (or resetting) your password within 24 hours to continue your registration. Please [complete a support request](#) if you have not activated your account within 24 hours.

What if I am new and setting up my Member Profile for the first time?

Select 'Yes, I'm new' if you have never registered to The Basketball Network before. An email will be sent to you. To continue, you must validate your email by selecting the link contained within the email.

Can you register more than one family member under the same email address?

Yes, you can register as many family members as you need under the same email address.

If your family member has never played basketball before you can add them as a new member from the right-hand side of the screen, as seen below:

If your family member has played basketball before and is not appearing on the left-hand side of the screen then please contact your association/club and ask them to update your family member's email address.

When I login, my name or a family member's name appears multiple times on the left-hand side of the screen. Which profile do I select?

It is important that you don't select an incorrect record as you may be inadvertently asked to register and pay when you are not due.

Please contact your local association/club to obtain the relevant FIBA ID number for your association/club when you are unsure which profile to select.

Your association/club will be able to provide you with the relevant profile and remove any duplicates from the system.

Why must I enter the information requested to participate in basketball?

This information allows the sport of basketball to grow in your local community. By providing this information, it can help your basketball association or club make decisions to administer the sport more efficiently and effectively, for the benefit of all. Who can access and use this information?

You can access and amend or update your personal information via member.basketball.net.au

This information is visible to your association/club, state and national governing body.

Why is there a 3.9% Service Fee?

All payments through the National Payment Gateway incur a 3.9% service fee. This service fee covers access to the solution that manages all of basketball registration, membership, competition, scoring and website requirements. For more details, please see [full breakdown on The Basketball Network page](#).

Why are my registration fees listed as separate amounts?

Products from your state, association and club can appear on your registration form, these products are unbundled. This means they have separate prices, so you can see how much each party receives. This provides transparency to all within the basketball community.

Why am I being asked to pay a state registration fee, which I know is not yet due?

You may have more than one member record within the system and the most recent is not allocated to your email.

Please contact your association/club and they will search all member records. If multiple records are found, they will merge them, which will resolve this issue.

Why are my registration fees not appearing on the registration form?

If your state product is not visible on your registration form, it may not be due yet. You can check this at member.basketball.net.au

If you know that you are due to make payment, you may have more than one member record within the system and the most recent record is not allocated to your email.

If you remain unsure about whether you have purchased all of the appropriate products on your registration form please contact your association/club directly.

Why are my registration fees already pre-selected for me?

If your product is pre-selected for you, this indicates your association/club has marked the product as mandatory.

If your state registration fee is pre-selected it means that your current registration has expired.

Please note that your association/club may also be using compulsory payments, meaning you will have to purchase your product in order to complete your registration.

Why is the registration form not allowing me to move to the next stage?

This is likely due to a compulsory question that has not been answered and/or a product not being selected. Please ensure you have answered all questions marked with an asterisk, and follow the screen prompts.

Why must I accept the National Terms and Conditions to continue?

By accepting the National Terms and Conditions, you are agreeing to have your information collected and securely stored within The Basketball Network.

You are also agreeing to the National Terms and Conditions of Participation. These are in place to protect all members participating within the basketball community.

What payment options are offered?

The below payment options are offered as default throughout The Basketball Network:

- Credit Card
- PayPal Account
- PoliPay – Online Banking

I don't have a credit card. How can I pay?

You can either use PayPal or PoliPay when completing purchases in 'The Basketball Network'. Both methods support secure debit card and bank deposit payments.

I have selected the Pay Now button, what should I do next?

It is important that once you have selected the Pay Now option, you allow the payment to be processed. Please allow time for the system to confirm your payment.

Please do not Refresh, or select the Back button during the payment process. Doing so may cause the system to process an additional or duplicate payment. If you have had an additional or duplicate payment taken from your card, please [complete](#) a support request at <http://basketball.net.au/tbnsupport> and make sure to include a bank statement showing the duplicate payments, as well as the first 6 digits of your payment card.

If you are using a mobile/tablet to make payment, please keep the payment screen tab open to enable the payment to be processed. Once the payment has been successfully completed, please close the tab.

Are online payments secure?

Yes, all payments through The Basketball Network are secured with SportsTG and the payment provider's security measures.

What is the Blue PayPal button for when selecting a credit card payment?

The Blue PayPal button is if you wish to use PayPal to complete your purchase.

If you wish to use your credit/debit card enter your details on the screen.

The credit card payment screen asks for a card number, MM/YY of expiry as well as the CVV code on the back of your card.

Do I require a PayPal account to complete my registration?

No, a PayPal account is not required to complete your basketball registration, it is one of three payment options available to you.

What is PoliPay and is it secure?

PoliPay is a payment provider which allows you to login to your bank account to complete a payment. This is suitable for people who do not have a credit/debit card or PayPal account but wish to complete payments online.

PoliPay is owned by Australia Post and is extremely secure with international security to the highest standard.

Why is Pay Later not available for my association/club?

Pay Later is only available for association/clubs where payment is not mandatory at the time of purchase.

I play at two different associations. How do I register for both?

Once you register and pay your state registration fee at one association, if you then register at another association whilst your membership is still active and login using your email credentials, you will not be asked to pay the state fee a second time.

The first one you register to in each calendar year is your primary association.

I have already paid my state registration fee this year, why am I being asked to pay again?

Some registration products are for a shorter term (eg. 14 days). However, if your registration period is still active then check your login credentials.

If you are logging in correctly and are still being asked to pay, please contact your association/club for further assistance.
