



Australian 3x3 Wheelchair Basketball Coach Expression of Interest – Head Coach

Basketball Australia is calling for Expressions of Interest for the position of Head Coach of the Australian 3x3 Wheelchair basketball program (men & women).

The term of appointment will be (part time) through to the end of December 2020, at which point the IWBF International program will be set, funding ratified, and a program review completed for progression through to Birmingham Commonwealth Games in 2022.

Duties and Responsibilities

The Head Coach of the Australian national program will be responsible for:

- Leadership in technical preparation and planning for the men & women teams
- Talent identification and selection of the athletes in consultation with the Basketball Australia Head of Wheelchair Basketball (HWCB) and nominated selection panel
- Leadership and conduct of any preparation camps and all squad related events
- Liaison with the National Team Coaches & HWCB on style of play and international trends
- Lead and conduct high level scouting and game preparation at tournaments
- Ability to lead a group of assistant coaches and support staff for the national program
- Representing the teams with promotion and media as required

Desired Experience and skill set –

- Basketball Australia Association Coach accreditation as a minimum
- Demonstrated experience coaching 3x3 basketball competition
- Coaching experience at a senior national / state league level of competitions
- Understanding of the international 3x3 wheelchair basketball game
- Functional knowledge of video editing, specifically Hudl/SportsCode

Remuneration

This Australian 3x3 Wheelchair Program Head Coach will receive an annual part-time payment for services for this period of appointment. Basketball Australia will pay all reasonable expenses incurred when the Head Coach is involved with approved team activities. This includes documented phone calls, travel and accommodation expenses.

If the Head Coach is injured when involved in national team activities, such injury will be covered under BA's sports injury insurance policy.

The successful candidate will be required to have a current Working with Children clearance or equivalent and hold a minimum Basketball Australia Association Coach level accreditation.
