



CODE OF CONDUCT FOR GOOD ADMINISTRATION - QUICK FACTS

Basketball Australia has developed a code of conduct which sets out the minimum expectations and requirements of Administrators to ensure the appropriate management of conduct within the sport.

The Good Administration of Basketball Code of Conduct applies to any Administrator employed or engaged by or contracted by Basketball Australia, any member Organisation or any Authorised Provider

- **Administrators must;**
 - Conduct the management of their basketball organisations in a professional, responsible and accountable manner which includes being responsible to their members
 - Ensure openness and transparency in all dealing of administration and operation
 - Avoid deception, unethical practices or any other behaviour that is detrimental to the sport of basketball
 - Comply with both the legal and moral duties of their role
 - Not to do anything that in any way denigrates the sport of basketball
 - Manage relationships and transaction with broadcasted, sponsors, commercial partners, vendors, suppliers, employees and consultants in an ethical way
 - Not to enter into agreements with organisations or persons whose business is related to speculation that is in breach of the integrity framework
 - Ensure timely disclosure of reports to Basketball Australia, FIBA, Sport Australia, Sport Integrity Australia and any other authority that may be required
 - Ensure personal rights and privacy of individuals are protected
 - Promote the physical and mental health/welfare of Athletes
 - Provide due process in any disciplinary matters not dealt with by Basketball Australia
- **Administrators must avoid or fully declare any potential conflict of interests against the Code of Conduct**
- **All instances of Prohibited Conduct must be reported in accordance with the Framework**
- **Basketball Australia has an Integrity unit and may conduct investigations into breach of the Code of Conduct**
